- Residents as Future Teachers: Basic instructional skills for residents who teach our clerkship students.
- OMERAD Seminar Series: College-wide faculty development sessions focusing on enhancing educator skills related to teaching and learning.
- Mentoring: Providing informal support to faculty engaged in educational scholarship.
- Office of Faculty Affairs and Development (FAD): OMERAD provides faculty support to career development and mentoring programs sponsored by FAD.
- Office of College-wide Assessment (CWA): OMERAD provides faculty and staff support to the design and implementation of college-level assessments such as the Block II and Block III Gateways.
- CHM Climate Survey: An annual survey of all medical students focusing on the learning environment and the infrastructure to support learning.
- CHM Student Performance and Outcomes Database: A student-level longitudinal database developed to support program evaluation and educational scholarship.
- CHM Outcomes Report: An annual program evaluation summary of current and historical educational outcomes related to undergraduate medical education.
- B-CLR: The Blended Curriculum Learning Resources group provides support for design and development of digital learning materials for face-to-face and online teaching and learning.
- CHM Graduate Follow-up Study: An annual survey of four cohorts of CHM graduates to evaluate their CHM education and document current practice characteristics.
- Academic Affairs Curriculum Database and Curriculum Mapping: OMERAD supports development of the curriculum database and its application to curriculum mapping.
- Program in Public Health: Collaboration to implement an alumni follow-up survey of MPH graduates.

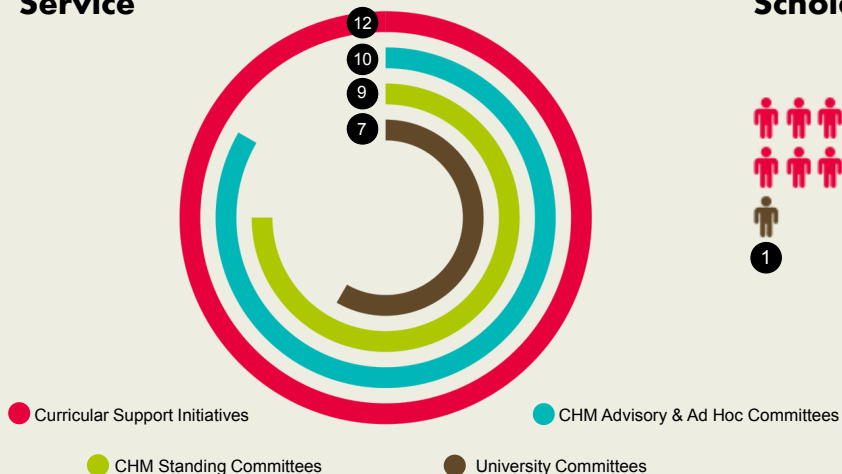
